The Land Of Milk And Honey

With the growing demand for products that are natural, healthy, and produced sustainably. Onetai Station, a 1450-hectare sheep and beef farm in Awakino, with a strong track-record in sustainable farming practices saw an opportunity to create a sustainably-produced product. By combining two of New Zealand's biggest exports – milk and manuka honey to capitalise on this trend with a new food spread.

Onetai's milk and honey spread has many uses. "It can be spread on toast, drizzled on cereal, used as a dessert topping, or mixed to make a hot drink. We're also looking into its potential as a sports supplement"

Corrie and the Rise Taupō team have been designing and building an export-grade dairy factory in Taupō. "As a team, we are focused on investing in the Taupō district. We have used local suppliers for the factory construction, professional services including marketing, banking and legal support. It's important that our product story is authentic – we want all parts of our production and marketing to be based right here in Taupō" says Corrie.

The team at Rise Taupō have received strong local support during the factory design and build process. "Organisations like Amplify have been really encouraging. They've helped connect us to local suppliers and made us feel welcome in this community."

Turangi Restaurant Is Hopping Good

Starting a business has been full of positives for Andrew and Lili, the owners of Turangi's eatery, The Hare and Copper. The pair moved to Turangi in 2019, and haven't looked back. "At first I was pretty nervous about the move," says Lili, who grew up in Mexico. "I thought living in a small rural town might be too much of an adjustment, as I've always lived in big cities" she says.

"We'd looked at business opportunities all over the North and South Island, but we kept coming back to Turangi" says Andrew. "My family has a bach at Kuratau and I've been coming to Ruapehu to ski for as long as I can remember" he says. With a young family, Turangi felt like the right move to balance a successful business and most importantly family time.

Finally, the right opportunity arose, so they decided to make the leap and start the business, doing most of the renovation work themselves, transforming what was previously River Wines Vineyard and Restaurant into a new bar and eatery. They opened in February 2020, getting in touch with local iwi to arrange a blessing. "Connecting with the local Māori culture here is really important to us, including learning about the history of the land and the people that have lived here for generations," says Andrew.

The pair see their business as a way to connect with and support the Turangi community. They hire and train local people, and invite local musicians to perform during summer weekends. "Turangi has so much to offer, there are so many amazingly talented people living here."
